HOW WE WORK

Seven principles that define how Axiom approaches every assignment, and the standards our clients can expect of our teams in the field.

01 / FIELD FIRST

We work at the **point of delivery.**

Our evidence is gathered where programmes actually operate — at the village, the health facility and the distribution site, rather than the regional capital or the partner office. Findings are grounded in direct observation of whether services are delivered as intended.

03 / BEYOND THE LOG-FRAME

We look **beyond the indicators.**

A programme's results are not confined to its indicators. Where a results framework is built on conservative measures, we identify achievements and limitations that fall outside it, so that the evaluation reflects what worked, what did not, and for whom.

05 / ANALYTICAL RIGOUR

We are **rigorous and analytical.**

We invest substantially in analysis — statistical methods, spatial analysis and network analysis — to identify the patterns and relationships in the data that underpin robust findings, conclusions and learning.

07 / DATA AS PROOF

We deliver **the full dataset.**

Every interview transcript, GPS coordinate and photograph is provided through an interactive dashboard, allowing clients to verify our work, re-run the analysis and draw their own conclusions. This transparency is the foundation of accountable evaluation.

02 / EVIDENCE-BASED CANDOUR

We report findings **honestly and in full.**

Procurement irregularities, ghost beneficiaries, inflated training records, weak theories of change and unsuitable results frameworks are documented wherever the evidence supports them. We substantiate every finding and report it clearly and professionally; the framing of sensitive messages to stakeholders remains the client's prerogative.

04 / HARD-TO-REACH ACCESS

We reach **where access is difficult.**

From Hargeisa to Las Anod, Sanaa to Marib, and Mogadishu to remote health facilities, our access derives from more than a decade of established field networks and credible local engagement rather than remote arrangements.

06 / FIELD-EARNED EVIDENCE

Our reports reflect **genuine field effort.**

Evaluation in hard-to-reach contexts is not a desk exercise. Every dataset reflects the time our enumerators spend in the field, the diligence of team leaders reconciling data in Mogadishu and Sanaa, and the carefully managed security considerations involved in reaching the communities that matter. This is what makes the evidence credible.

Two competing authorities, an active conflict and an intermittent blockade make Yemen one of the most demanding operating environments for monitoring and evaluation. Many firms manage their Yemen engagements remotely from Amman; genuine, sustained field presence is rare and is what distinguishes credible evidence in this context.

Axiom has been present in Yemen since 2017 — first in Sanaa, then in Aden — delivering TPM, programme evaluations, health and WASH studies, and cash-transfer verification through every phase of the conflict, across both areas of control, under single contracts. The portfolio below is the full set of contracts documented in the track record.

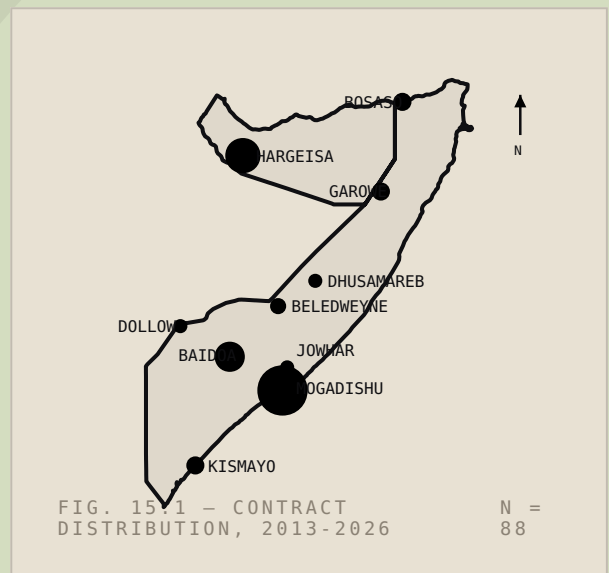

Axiom has run evaluations for IOM, DRC, NPA, CARE, Save the Children, NRC, IMC, WFP and the Geneva Call since 2019 — across Jonglei, Unity, Upper Nile, Western Bahr el Ghazal, Lakes State, GPAA and Eastern Equatoria. Twelve documented assignments to date.

Twelve assignments across seven states since 2019, for nine clients including WFP, IOM and Geneva Call, each delivered in a logistically complex operating environment.

An active conflict since April 2023. Despite limited international attention, cash transfers to 52,000 beneficiaries continue to require independent verification, and Axiom maintains the field presence to deliver it.

Axiom holds an active UNICEF Sudan PDM contract running across Kassala and Red Sea states, monitoring the MCCT+ project through six rounds of Post-Distribution Monitoring delivered as live interactive dashboards.

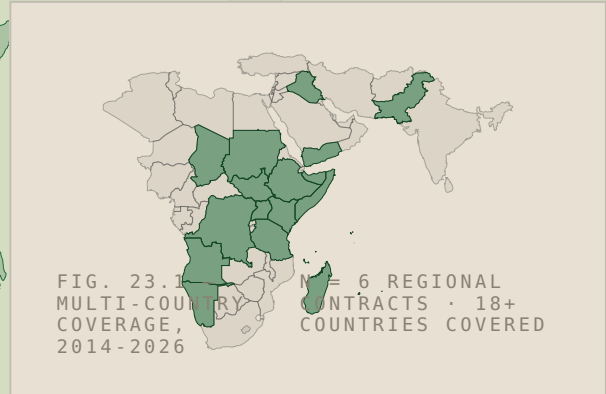
